DISTRACTED-DRIVING LAWS

According to information compiled by the Governors Highway Safety Association (www.ghsa.org), talking on handheld cell phones while driving is prohibited in Arizona, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Georgia, Hawaii, Illinois, Maine, Maryland, Minnesota, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Oregon, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Vermont, Washington, West Virginia, and District of Columbia.

All but two states (Minnesota and Montana) currently prohibit text messaging for drivers of all ages. Visit the Governors Highway Safety Association's website for additional laws by state, including speed limits, aggressive driving, drowsy driving, seat belts, and more.
